## September 2018 BOM (Denise Jameson)

Test your $1 / 4$ " seam BEFORE sewing your block by sewing 3 pieces of fabric $1-1 / 2 \times 3-1 / 2$ together in rows. Measure the centre seam. It should be exactly 1 " wide. Make adjustments to your needle position and/or the line on your machine to correct if it is wrong.


Fabric Requirements:
Based on fabrics that are 42 " wide. One block finishes 12.5 " square.
Fabric A - included GREY
3 " width of fabric (WOF) strip (from this, cut $\mathbf{A 4}$ first and then all of the 1.5 " wide pieces)
You will supply 3 other fabrics, preferably solids to maintain the 'modern' look to this quilt.

## Fabric B

1.5" WOF strip

## Fabric C

2" WOF strip (from this, cut C2 and C5 before cutting 1.5" wide pieces)

## Fabric D

$3.5 " \times 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ scrap or bigger

## Cutting:

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\begin{aligned}
& \mathrm{A} 1, \mathrm{~A} 3, \mathrm{~A} 5, \mathrm{~A} 6=1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5 " \\
& \mathrm{~A} 2=1.5 " \times 4.5 \\
& \mathrm{~A} 4=3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3 "
\end{aligned}
$$

$B 1, B 2$ and $B 3=1.5 " \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
$\mathrm{C} 1, \mathrm{C} 3, \mathrm{C} 4, \mathrm{C} 6=1.5 " \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
$\mathrm{C} 2, \mathrm{C} 5=3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2 "$
$\mathrm{D} 1=3.5 " \times 3 "$
$D 2=1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$

Assembling the Block:

1. Assemble C1, B2, C3 and C4, B3, C6.
2. Assemble B1 and A2.
3. Assemble portion C1/B2/C3 to C2 and A4.
4. Assemble portion C4/B3/C6 to C5 and D1.
5. Now, working left to right assemble A1, B1/A2, A3, Portion 1, A5, Portion 2, D2 and A6. Your block is complete- Quick and simple!
